THE EMERGENCIES COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Emergency Powers and Planning (Jersey) Law 1990, have made the following Act –

The Minister for Justice and Home Affairs is designated as the competent authority in relation to –

- (a) fuel and electricity; and
- (b) gas,

for the purposes of Articles 5 and 7 respectively of the <u>Emergency Powers and Planning</u> (Jersey) Law 1990.

This Act may be cited as the Emergency Powers and Planning (Competent Authority) (Fuel, Electricity and Gas) (Jersey) Act 1991.
