TOURISM (AMENDMENT No. 4) (JERSEY) LAW. 1988.

A LAW to amend further the Tourism (Jersey) Law, 1948, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

18th day of DECEMBER, 1987.

(Registered on the 12th day of February, 1988.)

STATES OF JERSEY.

The 29th day of September, 1987.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

1. In sub-paragraph (e) of paragraph (1) of Article 10 of the Tourism (Jersey) Law, 1948, as amended,¹ the words “, not exceeding two pounds sterling,” shall be deleted.

2. This Law may be cited as the Tourism (Amendment No. 4) (Jersey) Law, 1988.
