**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

**ARTICLE 1**

In paragraph (2) of Article 1 of the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Jersey) Law, 1957,<sup>1</sup> as amended,<sup>2</sup> for the words “five pounds” there shall be substituted the words “twenty pounds”.

**ARTICLE 2**

This Law may be cited as the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law, 1981.
