THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

ARTICLE 1

In paragraph (2) of Article 1 of the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Jersey) Law, 1957, as amended, for the words "five pounds" there shall be substituted the words "twenty pounds".

ARTICLE 2

This Law may be cited as the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law, 1981.
