A LAW

to amend the Fatal Accidents (Jersey) Law 1962, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

### STATES OF JERSEY

The 19th day of November 1996

**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

#### ARTICLE 1

After paragraph (1) of Article 4 of the Fatal Accidents (Jersey) Law 1962<sup>1</sup> there shall be inserted the following new paragraph –

"(1A) In assessing damages payable to the spouse or child of a deceased person in respect of the death of that deceased person in any action under this Law, no account shall be taken of the re-marriage or prospects of remarriage of the spouse of the deceased person.".

### ARTICLE 2

(1) This Law may be cited as the Fatal Accidents (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1997.
