**MISUSE OF DRUGS (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) LAW, 1983**

**A LAW** to amend the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law, 1978, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

**27th day of JULY, 1983.**

**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law: -

In paragraph (2) of Article 17 of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law, 1978<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”) for the words “to seize and detain those drugs” there shall be substituted the words “or that a document so found is such a document as is mentioned in sub-paragraph (b) of this paragraph, to seize and detain those drugs or that document, as the case may be”.

**ARTICLE 2**

In sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to the Law<sup>2</sup> for the word “N-alkyl- $\alpha$ -methylphenethylamine”, in the second place where it occurs, there shall be substituted the word “N-Alkyl- $\alpha$ -ethylphenethylamine”.
