**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law: -

**ARTICLE 1**

In the first paragraph of Article 23 of the Court of Appeal (Jersey) Law, 1961,<sup>1</sup> for the words “or the Deputy Bailiff” there shall be substituted the words “the Deputy Bailiff or an ordinary judge of the Court of Appeal”.

**ARTICLE 2**

This Law may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Amendment) (Jersey) Law, 1976.
