**HEALTH INSURANCE (AMENDMENT No. 11) (JERSEY) LAW
1996**

A LAW to amend further the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967,
sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

26th day of JUNE 1996

(Registered on the 19th day of July 1996)

STATES OF JERSEY

The 26th day of March 1996

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent
Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

ARTICLE 1

For paragraph (8) of Article 24 of the Health Insurance (Jersey)
Law 1967,¹ as amended,² there shall be substituted the following
paragraph –

“(8) Subject to paragraph (9) of this Article, the
Committee –

- (a) shall approve medicines, drugs, appliances and
materials as items of pharmaceutical benefit for the
purposes of this Law;
- (b) in so approving them, may make different provision –

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- (i) for medicines and drugs that may be prescribed by approved medical practitioners, approved dentists and registered dentists respectively; and
- (ii) for appliances and materials that may be prescribed by approved medical practitioners and approved dentists respectively; and
- (c) may at any time alter, revoke or vary any such approval.”.

ARTICLE 2

This Law may be cited as the Health Insurance (Amendment No. 11) (Jersey) Law 1996.
