**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law: -

**ARTICLE 1**

In paragraph (2) of Article 5 of the Royal Court (Jersey) Law, 1948, as amended<sup>1</sup> -

- (a) in sub-paragraph (e) the words “, admitted not less than seven years before the meeting of the Electoral College,” shall be deleted;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (f) the words “admitted not less than seven years before the meeting of the Electoral College” shall be deleted.
