**THE STATES,** subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

### ARTICLE 1

After the words "if it has been coined in or for any of Her Majesty's Mints," in Article 1(2)(a) of the Currency Offences (Jersey) Law 1952<sup>1</sup> there shall be inserted the words "or has been lawfully coined in or for any foreign country,".

### **ARTICLE 2**

This Law may be cited as the Currency Offences (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 2001 and shall come into force on the seventh day following its registration.
