## HEALTH INSURANCE (AMENDMENT No. 13) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

A LAW to amend further the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967.

*Adopted by the States* 21st January 2003

*Sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council* 12th June 2003

*Registered by the Royal Court* 11th July 2003

**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

**1**

In this Law, “principal Law” means the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967,<sup>1</sup> as amended.<sup>2</sup>

**2**

In Article 44(1) of the principal Law,<sup>3</sup> for the words “he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and such imprisonment” there shall be substituted the words “he shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven years or to a fine, or both”.

**3**

Article 7(a) of the Health Insurance (Amendment No. 9) (Jersey) Law 1996<sup>4</sup> shall be deleted.

**4**

This Law may be cited as the Health Insurance (Amendment No. 13) (Jersey) Law 2003 and shall come into force on the seventh day following its registration.
