MOTOR VEHICLES (CONSTRUCTION AND USE) (AMENDMENT No. 5) (JERSEY) ORDER 2004

THE HOME AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, in pursuance of Articles 39A and 42 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, orders as follows –

1 Amendment

For Article 2(7) of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Jersey) Order 1998² there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

- "(7) For the purposes of Article 39A(2) of the Law,³ the fee to accompany an application for a licence authorizing the use of a vehicle not complying with orders under Article 39 of the Law⁴ shall be
 - (a) if the application is for a licence for the use of the vehicle on a specified journey or for a specified purpose or for a period of not more than 12 months £69.40;
 - (b) if the application is for a licence for the use of the vehicle in any other case -£123.90;
 - (c) if the actual application is a second or subsequent application (after an earlier application under Article 39A of the Law⁵ was refused within the period of 30 days before the actual application was made) and both or all the applications are for a licence for the use of the vehicle as referred to in sub-paragraph (b) £61.95.".

2 Revocation

The Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Amendment No. 4) (Jersey) Order 2002⁶ shall be revoked.

3 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Amendment No. 5) (Jersey) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 2nd February 2004.
