INCOME SUPPORT (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2008

Made

Coming into force in accordance with Regulation 4

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 5(5) and 18(1) of the Income Support (Jersey) Law 2007¹, have made the following Regulations –

1 Interpretation

In these Regulations "principal Regulations" means the Income Support (Jersey) Regulations 2007^2 .

2 Schedule 1 amended

For paragraph 6(3)(c) and (d) of Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following clauses –

"(c)	for a score of at least 56 where the member of the household is not receiving appropriate residential care	£122.85
(d)	for a score of at least 56 where the member of the household is receiving residential care that is approved by the Minister	£436.73".

3 Schedule 3 amended

In paragraph (b) of Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations, for the substituted sub-paragraph (3)(c)(d) there shall be substituted the following clauses –

"(c)	for a score of at least 56 where the member of the household is not receiving appropriate residential care	£126.56
(d)	for a score of at least 56 where the member of the household is receiving residential care that is approved by the Minister	£436.73".

4 Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Income Support (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 2008.
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3), these Regulations shall come into force on 28th January 2008.
- (3) Regulation 3 shall come into force on the same day as Schedule 3 of the principal Regulations.
