THE MINISTER FOR SOCIAL SECURITY, in pursuance of Articles 15 and 36 of the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967¹, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order, "principal Order" means the Health Insurance (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (General Provisions) (No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2002².

2 Amendment of Article 7

Paragraphs (5) to (8) of Article 7 of the principal Order shall be repealed.

3 Amendment of Article 9

Article 9(6) of the principal Order shall be repealed.

4 Amendment of Schedule 2

In paragraph 8(3) of Schedule 2 to the principal Order the words "and the receipt of prescription charges" shall be deleted.

5 Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Health Insurance (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (General Provisions) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 5) (Jersey) Order 2008.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on 1st February 2008.
