THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 7 and 72 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002¹, have made the following Regulations –

1 Regulation 2 of Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 amended

After Regulation 2(1) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002² there shall be inserted the following paragraph –

"(1A) For the purposes of Article 7(1)(a) of the Law, the prescribed form of statement is Form 1A.".

2 Form 1A inserted in Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002

In the Schedule to the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 after Form 1 there shall be inserted Form 1A in the Schedule to these Regulations.

3 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elections (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 2006 and shall come into force on 21st March 2006.
