**ROAD TRAFFIC (DISABLED PERSONS)
(PARKING) (AMENDMENT No. 4) (JERSEY)
ORDER 2006**

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Articles 63, 64 and 84 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956¹, and after consultation with the Connétable of St. Helier, orders as follows –

1 Schedule 1 amended

In Schedule 1 to the Road Traffic (Disabled Persons) (Parking) (Jersey) Order 2002² –

- (a) in the item “Broad Street” in column 1, there shall be substituted for the entry opposite in column 2 the following entry –

“North side (between a point 50 yards east of the western boundary of No. 36 Broad Street and a point 11 yards further east)”;

- (b) after the item “Parade, The (eastern arm)” in column 1 and the entry opposite in column 2 there shall be inserted, in column 1, the following item and, in column 2 opposite, the following entries –

“Parade, The (western arm)

West side (between a point 10 yards north of the northern boundary of the Town Hall and a point 12 yards further north)”.

West side (between a point 99 yards north of its junction with Gloucester Street and a point 13 yards further north)”.

2 Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Disabled Persons) (Parking) (Amendment No. 4) (Jersey) Order 2006.
- (2) This Order shall come into force 7 days after it is made.
