

POLICING OF PARKS (AMENDMENT No. 4) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2012

Made 1st May 2012
Coming into force 8th May 2012

THE STATES, in pursuance of Order in Council of 26th December 1851¹ and Article 92 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956², have made the following Regulations –

1 Interpretation

In these Regulations "principal Regulations" mean the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 2005³.

2 Article 1 amended

In Article 1 of the principal Regulations before the definition "authorized person" there shall be inserted the following definition –

- " 'assistance dog' means –
- (a) a dog which has been trained to guide a blind person;
- (b) a dog which has been trained to assist a deaf person;
- (c) a dog which has been trained to assist a person who has a disability, provided that the person is able to produce a certificate or other confirmation in writing by a medical practitioner within the meaning of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1960⁴, or by a person who is the equivalent of such a person in a country or territory outside Jersey, that the person has the disability."

3 Article 5 amended

For Article 5(2) of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

"(2) A person in charge of an assistance dog, such person being the person whom the dog has been trained to assist, may take the dog into a park.".

4 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Policing of Parks (Amendment No. 4) (Jersey) Regulations 2012 and shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
