MEDICINES (PRESCRIPTION ONLY) (AMENDMENT No. 5) (JERSEY) ORDER 2003

Made 6th August 2003
Coming into force 13th August 2003

THE HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in pursuance of Articles 57 and 111 of the Medicines (Jersey) Law 1995, orders as follows –

1 Extension of exemption

For Article 10 of the Medicines (Prescription Only) (Jersey) Order 1997^2 there shall be substituted the following Article –

"10 Exemption for sale or supply in hospitals or the prison

The restrictions in Article 57(2)(a) of the Law³ shall not apply to the sale or supply of any prescription only medicine –

- (a) in the course of the business of a hospital; or
- (b) by a pharmacy to the prison under the terms of a contract to supply medicinal products for the benefit of prisoners,

in accordance with the written directions of a doctor or a dentist, even though those directions do not fulfil the conditions in Article 6(2) of this Order.".

2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Medicines (Prescription Only) (Amendment No. 5) (Jersey) Order 2003 and shall come into force 7 days after it is made.
