

INCOME SUPPORT (AMENDMENT No. 16) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2017

Made
Coming into force

19th July 2017 1st October 2017

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 5 and 18 of the Income Support (Jersey) Law 2007¹, have made the following Regulations –

1 Schedule 1 to the Income Support (Jersey) Regulations 2007 amended

In Schedule 1 to the Income Support (Jersey) Regulations 2007² –

- (a) in paragraph 2(1)
 - (i) for clause (a) there shall be substituted the following clause –

"(a)	under Article 5(2)(a) (adult component	£94.85",
	rate)	

(ii) for clauses (d), (e) and (f) there shall be substituted the following clauses -

"(d)	under Article 5(2)(c) of the Law (first child component rate) £65.87
(e)	under Article 5(2)(ca) of the Law £65.87 (subsequent child component rate)
(f)	under Article 5(2)(d) of the Law £52.85"; (household component rate)

(b) for paragraph 4(2) there shall be substituted the following subparagraph –

"(2) The rates payable under this sub-paragraph are –

(a)	in the case of a hostel	£103.04
(b)	in the case of lodgings or a bedsit	£135.73
(c)	in the case of a flat with 1 bedroom	£200.13

(d)	in the case of a flat with 2 bedrooms	£256.27
(e)	in the case of a flat with 3 or more bedrooms	£275.03
(f)	in the case of a house with 1 bedroom	£229.39
(g)	in the case of a house with 2 bedrooms	£291.27
(h)	in the case of a house with 3 bedrooms	£340.13
(i)	in the case of a house with 4 bedrooms	£370.79
(j)	in the case of a house with 5 or more bedrooms	£410.48.";

- (c) for paragraph 4(7) there shall be substituted the following subparagraph -
 - "(7) The rates payable under this sub-paragraph are –

(a)	in the case of a bedsit or flat with 1 or 2 bedrooms	£6.58	
(b)	in the case of a flat with 3 bedrooms	£9.31	
(c)	in the case of a flat with 4 or more bedrooms	£13.16	
(d)	in the case of a house with 1 bedroom	£6.58	
(e)	in the case of a house with 2 bedrooms	£9.31	
(f)	in the case of a house with 3 or more bedrooms	£13.16.";	

- (d) for paragraph 4(13) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph
 - "(13) The rates payable under this sub-paragraph are –

(a)	in the case of a hostel	£103.04	
(b)	in the case of lodgings or a bedsit	£128.59	
(c)	in the case of a flat with 1 bedroom	£189.63	
(d)	in the case of a flat with 2 bedrooms	£242.76	
(e)	in the case of a flat with 3 or more bedrooms	£260.54	
(f)	in the case of a house with 1 bedroom	£217.28	
(g)	in the case of a house with 2 bedrooms	£276.01	
(h)	in the case of a house with 3 bedrooms	£322.21	
(i)	in the case of a house with 4 bedrooms	£351.26	
(j)	in the case of a house with 5 or more bedrooms	£388.85.";	

(e)	for	paragraph 6(3)	there	shall	be	substituted	the	following	sub-
	para	agraph –							

- "(3) The rate of personal care element payable in respect of the total score calculated under sub-paragraph (2) is as follows
 - (a) for a score of at least 15 but less than 36 £23.66
 - (b) for a score of at least 36 but less than 56 £104.09
 - (c) For a score of at least 56 £149.52.";
- (f) for paragraph 7(3) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph
 - "(3) The rate of mobility element of the impairment component is
 - (a) £23.66; or
 - (b) £47.32 if the person's average weekly earnings exceed the amount in this clause.";
- (g) for paragraph 8(2) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph
 - "(2) The rate of clinical cost element of the impairment component is
 - (a) £3.29; or
 - (b) if, based on the criteria set out in sub-paragraph (1)(b), the member will need at least 9 consultations with an approved medical practitioner, £6.58.";
- (h) for paragraph 10(3) there shall be substituted the following subparagraph
 - "(3) The rates payable under this sub-paragraph are
 - (a) for a child under the age of 3 years

£6.79

(b) for a child aged 3 years or over

£5.30.";

- (i) for paragraph 12 there shall be substituted the following paragraph –
- "12 Rate for the carer's component

The rate payable in respect of the carer's component is £48.37.".

2 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Income Support (Amendment No. 16) (Jersey) Regulations 2017 and shall come into force on 1st October 2017.
