## **SOCIAL SECURITY (MARRIED WOMEN) (AMENDMENT No. 3) (JERSEY) ORDER 2004**

*21st July 2004*

*Coming into force*

*1st October 2004*

**THE EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY COMMITTEE**, in pursuance of Article 45 of the Social Security (Jersey) Law 1974<sup>1</sup> and Article 18 of the Social Security (Amendment No. 14) (Jersey) Law 2000,<sup>2</sup> orders as follows –

### **1 Interpretation**

In this Order, “principal Order” means the Social Security (Married Women) (Jersey) Order 1974.<sup>3</sup>

### **2 Article 3 amended**

- (1) In the heading to Article 3 of the principal Order, the words “, ACCIDENT BENEFIT” shall be deleted.
- (2) In Article 3(1) of the principal Order, the words “, accident benefit” shall be deleted.

### **3 Article 4 amended**

For Article 4(1) of the principal Order there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

“(1) Subject to the following provisions of this Article, where a woman ceases to be entitled to survivor’s allowance otherwise than by reason of re-marriage or cohabitation with another person of either sex –

- (a) she shall be deemed to have satisfied the contribution conditions for short term incapacity allowance set out in sub-

- paragraph (1)(a) of paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to the Law;<sup>4</sup>
- (b) she shall be deemed to have satisfied the contribution conditions for long term incapacity allowance, incapacity pension and old age pension set out in sub-paragraph (1)(a) of paragraph 2, sub-paragraph (1)(a) of paragraph 3 and sub-paragraph (1)(a) of paragraph 6 respectively of that Schedule.<sup>5</sup>”

#### **4 Revocation**

Article 4(1) of the Social Security (Married Women) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2001<sup>6</sup> is revoked.

#### **5 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Married Women) (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 1st October 2004.
