ROAD TRAFFIC (DISABLED PERSONS) (BADGES FOR MOTOR VEHICLES) (AMENDMENT No. 3) (JERSEY) ORDER 2023

THE MINISTER FOR INFRASTRUCTURE makes this Order under Articles 60 and 84 of the [Road Traffic \(Jersey\) Law 1956](#) –

1 [Road Traffic \(Disabled Persons\) \(Badges for Motor Vehicles\) \(Jersey\) Order 1982](#) amended

For Article 3 (description of disabled persons) of the [Road Traffic \(Disabled Persons\) \(Badges for Motor Vehicles\) \(Jersey\) Order 1982](#) there is substituted –

“3 Description of disabled persons

- (1) A person may apply for a disabled person’s badge if they –
 - (a) have a permanent and substantial disability that causes inability to walk or very considerable difficulty in walking; or
 - (b) are registered with EYECAN or have a certificate from EYECAN to the effect that the person is blind.
- (2) “EYECAN” is the name of the charity registered with the Jersey Charity Commissioner under number 244 (and with the legal form of a Jersey body corporate, with non-profit organisation number 0362, and with The Jersey Blind Society recorded as another name).”

2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Disabled Persons) (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Order 2023 and comes into force 7 days after it is made.
