MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT No. 18) (JERSEY) ORDER 2010

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Articles 4, 7, and 16 of the Motor Vehicle Registration (Jersey) Law 1993¹, orders as follows –

1 Interpretation

In this Order “principal Order” means the Motor Vehicle Registration (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1993².

2 Article 1 amended

In Article 1 of the principal Order after the definition “Law” there shall be inserted the following definition –

“‘LPV’ means a light passenger vehicle, being a motor vehicle designed and constructed for the carriage of passengers and comprising no more than 8 seats in addition to the driver’s seat;”.

3 Article 5 amended

In Article 5 of the principal Order after paragraph (b)(iii) there shall be added the following sub-paragraphs –

- “(iv) the owner’s Jersey driving licence, if the owner is an individual, and
- (v) evidence satisfactory to the Inspector of the ownership of the vehicle.”.

4 Schedule 1 amended

In Schedule 1 to the principal Order after item 23 there shall be added the following item –

“24. CO₂ emission rate (LPVs only)”.

5 Schedule 2 amended

In Schedule 2 to the principal Order –

(a) after paragraph 5 there shall be inserted the following paragraph –

“5A. Where an application is made under the Law for the registration of any motor vehicle, the Inspector shall, before registering the vehicle, require to be discharged any liability for any outstanding duty or tax payable in respect of the vehicle –

- (a) under the Customs and Excise (Jersey) Law 1999³;
- (b) under the Goods and Services Tax (Jersey) Law 2007⁴; or
- (c) which is otherwise payable to Agent of the Impôts.”;

(b) in paragraph 6(1) the words “ownership and” shall be deleted.

6 Schedule 3 substituted

For Schedule 3 to the principal Order there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.

7 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Registration (General Provisions) (Amendment No. 18) (Jersey) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 1st September 2010.

NOTES RELATING TO PRESCRIBED PARTICULARS NUMBERED OVERLEAF

- (5) If you are resident in Jersey, give the address at which you live. This must not be a hotel or business address unless you live there permanently. If you are not permanently resident in Jersey give an address at which you can be contacted. For a company owner give the address of the company's principal place of business in the Island or its registered office.
- (8) The inspector has discretion to refuse registration if the owner is not permanently resident.
- (17) You must give a full description of the vehicle body e.g. 2, 3, 4 or 5 door saloon (hatchbacks are either 3 or 5 door saloons), platform lorry, dropside lorry, Luton van, goods light (under 1525kg), good heavy (over 1525kg), van light (under 1525kg), van heavy (over 1525kg) or other full description of the body type.
- (18) Only complete if the vehicle is a goods carrying vehicle weighing over 1525kg.
- (24) Only complete if the vehicle is over 9.3 meters (30ft 6ins) long if a rigid vehicle or 11 metres long (36ft 1 inch) if an articulated vehicle.
- (25) Only complete if the vehicle is over 2.3 meters (7ft 6½ ins) wide.
- (26) Type approval numbers should be obtainable from vehicle main dealers and V55s.
- (27) The vehicle mileage/kilometre reading can be found on the odometer which is usually located on or within the speedometer.
- (29) Give the date and nature of the damage resulting in the insurance write off and the name of the insurer at that time.
- (31) CO₂ data is only accepted from a V55/1 form, an EU whole vehicle type certificate, a type approval certificate issued by a motor vehicle manufacturer or a motor vehicle registration certificate issued by a governmental vehicle registration department.
