## ROAD TRAFFIC (SPEED LIMITS) (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2003

*Made**9th September 2003**Coming into force**9th September 2003*

**THE ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE**, in pursuance of Articles 13A and 42 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956,<sup>1</sup> orders as follows –

### **1 Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Jersey) Order 2003 amended**

For Articles 1 to 4 of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Jersey) Order 2003<sup>2</sup> there shall be substituted the following Articles –

#### **“1 Interpretation**

In this Order “road” includes part of a road.

#### **2 30 mph speed limit-**

A motor vehicle shall not be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on a road specified in Schedule 1.

#### **3 20 mph speed limit**

A motor vehicle shall not be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on a road specified in Schedule 2.

#### **4 15 mph speed limit**

A motor vehicle shall not be driven at a speed exceeding 15 miles per hour on a road specified in Schedule 3.”.

**2 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Amendment) (Jersey) Order 2003 and shall come into force on 9th September 2003.
