THE EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY COMMITTEE, in pursuance of Articles 24(6) and 46 of the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967,¹ orders as follows –

1 Schedule 5 amended

In Schedule 5 to the Health Insurance (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (General Provisions) (No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2002² for item 2(e) there shall be substituted the following item –

- “(e) the following drugs if the prescription is endorsed ‘C.D.’ by the approved supplier –
