## **INCOME SUPPORT (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT No. 7) (JERSEY) ORDER 2011**

*2nd September 2011*

*Coming into force*

*1st October 2011*

**THE MINISTER FOR SOCIAL SECURITY**, in pursuance of Articles 7 and 18 of the Income Support (Jersey) Law 2007<sup>1</sup>, orders as follows –

### **1 Interpretation**

In this Order “principal Order” means the Income Support (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 2008<sup>2</sup>.

### **2 Schedule 2 amended**

In Schedule 2 to the principal Order for paragraphs 5(f) and (g) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraphs –

- “(f) 100% of the first £42.28 of any income derived from a pension or annuity of one person in the household aged 65 years or over;
- (g) 100% of the first £27.23 of any income derived from a pension or annuity of any other person in the household aged 65 years or over;”.

### **3 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Income Support (General Provisions) (Amendment No. 7) (Jersey) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 1st October 2011.
