## **MOTOR CARS (DRIVING INSTRUCTION) (AMENDMENT No. 19) (JERSEY) ORDER 2008**

*Made*

*4th December 2008*

*Coming into force*

*1st January 2009*

**THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES**, in pursuance of Articles 6, 7 and 84 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956<sup>1</sup>, orders as follows –

### **1 Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Jersey) Order 1982 amended**

For Article 7 of the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Jersey) Order 1982<sup>2</sup> there shall be substituted the following Article –

#### **“7 Fees**

- (1) A person applying to submit himself or herself to the written part of the examination shall pay a fee of £78.25.
- (2) A person applying to submit himself or herself to the practical part of the examination shall pay a fee of £78.25.
- (3) The fee to be paid by a person who applies for the retention of his or her name in the register for a further period of 4 years shall be £155.80.
- (4) The fee to be paid by a person who applies for the entry of his or her name in the register shall be £155.80.”

### **2 Revocation**

The Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment No. 18) (Jersey) Order 2007<sup>3</sup> is revoked.

**3 Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment No. 19) (Jersey) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 1st January 2009.
