HARBOURS (AMENDMENT No. 35) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2002

(Promulgated on the 11th day of December 2002)

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Harbours (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1961,¹ as amended,² have made the following Regulations -

1. For the First Schedule to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962, as amended,³ there shall be substituted the schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

2. The Harbours (Amendment No. 33) (Jersey) Regulations 2001⁴ shall be repealed.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment No. 35) (Jersey) Regulations 2002 and shall come into force on 1st January 2003.
