LEGISLATION (AMENDING POWER) (JERSEY) LAW 1999

A **LAW** to enable the States to make Regulations amending a Law for restricted purposes and in restricted circumstances

Commencement [[see endnotes](#)]

1 Interpretation

In this Law –

“lodged” means lodged in accordance with standing orders made under the [States of Jersey Law 2005](#); and

“registered” means registered by the Royal Court.²

2 Power to make Regulations

The States may by Regulations make amendments to any Law (the “first Law”) which are incidental or supplemental to or consequential upon another Law (the “second Law”) where –

- (a) the proposition for the passing of the second Law is lodged before the day on which the first Law is registered; and
- (b) the second Law is registered on or after the day on which the proposition for the passing of the first Law is lodged.

3 Citation

This Law may be cited as the Legislation (Amending Power) (Jersey) Law 1999.
