HEALTH CARE (REGISTRATION) (PRESCRIBED QUALIFICATIONS) (JERSEY) ORDER 2003

THE HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in pursuance of Articles 3 and 17 of the [Health Care \(Registration\) \(Jersey\) Law 1995](#), orders as follows –

1 Interpretation¹

In this Order –

“Health Professions Order” means the Health Professions Order 2001 of the United Kingdom (S.I. 2002/254);

“prescription only medicine” has the same meaning as in the [Medicines \(Prescription Only\) \(Jersey\) Order 1997](#).

2 Prescribed qualifications

A qualification specified in column 1 of an entry in the Schedule is a prescribed qualification for the registrable occupation specified in column 2 of that entry.

2A Consequential provision²

For the purposes of the [Health Care \(Registration\) \(Jersey\) Law 1995](#), a person who is, immediately before the commencement of this Article, registered in respect of the following registrable occupations is taken to be registered as a nurse independent prescriber –

- (a) a midwife prescribing practitioner;
- (b) a nurse prescribing practitioner; and
- (c) a specialist community public health nurse prescribing practitioner.

3 Citation

This Order may be cited as the Health Care (Registration) (Prescribed Qualifications) (Jersey) Order 2003.
