SPRING TRAPS (APPROVAL) (JERSEY) ORDER 1996

THE ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE, in pursuance of Article 2 of the <u>Animals (Trapping) (Jersey) Law 1961</u>, orders as follows –

For the purposes of Article 2 of the <u>Animals (Trapping) (Jersey) Law 1961</u>, the spring traps specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order are approved subject to the conditions specified in the second column thereof as to the animals for which, or the circumstances in which, the spring traps may respectively be used.

This Order may be cited as the Spring Traps (Approval) (Jersey) Order 1996.

SCHEDULE

(Article 1)
